9 gennaio 1878
Muore Vittorio Emanuele II in Roma.

16 maggio 1878
Legge che ordina l'erezione in Roma di un monumento nazionale alla memoria del Re Vittorio Emanuele II, liberatore della Patria, fondatore della sua unità.

25 luglio 1880
Legge che dispone l'esecuzione di tale monumento.

21 settembre 1880
Primo bando di concorso mondiale per il monumento.

9 January 1878
King Victor Emanuel II dies in Rome.

16 May 1878
Enactment of the law ordering the a national monument to be built in Rome to honour the memory of King Victor Emmanuel II, the liberator of the Homeland, and founder of the United Italy.

25 July 1880
Enactment of the law to begin work on the monument.

12 December 1882
Second tender for the monument, to build "an equestrian statue in an architectural setting and with appropriate monumental staircases" on the northern side of the Capitoline Hill.

8 February 1884
The Reale Insigne Accademia di San Luca declares its preference for Giuseppe Sacconi's project, stating the grounds for its choice.

24 June 1884
Giuseppe Sacconi is adjudicated to build the monument.

30 December 1884
Giuseppe Sacconi is appointed Project Manager and Superintendent.

22 March 1885
King Umberto I solemnly lays the Vittoriano Foundation stone.

28 April 1885
Tender for the equestrian statue.

15 December 1886
The excavation and demolition of the Capitoline Hill begins.

3 June 1890
Giuseppe Sacconi completes his second design for the Vittoriano.

1 June 1886
King Umberto I, accompanied by Queen Margherita, visits the Vittoriano and expresses his satisfaction.

4 June 1891
King Umberto I gives to the Vittoriano, placed in all the municipalities of Italy.

20 June 1891
Queen Margherita visits the Vittoriano, accompanied by King Umberto I.

May 1895 and 25 July 1896
The Vittoriano is inaugurated in the presence of King Umberto I and Queen Margherita.

17 June 1892
The Vittoriano is inaugurated in the presence of King Umberto I and Queen Margherita.

12 December 1896
The Vittoriano is inaugurated in the presence of King Umberto I and Queen Margherita.

2 January 1897
The Vittoriano is inaugurated in the presence of King Umberto I and Queen Margherita.
